- a) As per government order no. 1041-11-5-78 dated 11-5-78 to have commenced the project of setting a primary school at Rajawade, Indore, Madhya Pradesh, India.

One kilometer from the place where this institution intends to open there was no existing primary school at the time and it is necessary for this institution to cater to the educational needs of the local. According to the judgement of the Honorable Supreme Court, the constitutional right of free education to children under the age of 14 years has been upheld and provision made mandatory.

State government responsibility cannot pass through private educational institution and other organizations. And with the aim of giving parent and children full freedom of choice and said school has been registered and permanent now aided work, because of the initiative of the said educational institution.

If under no circumstance the educational institution is not permitted to open under distance without the consent of the Department.

1) Screening shall be done only in the medium and at the same location for which the school has been sanctioned and shall not be allowed to change location for any reason.

2) The school shall remain at the same place and under the same name as the board of trustees for which permission has been granted to register the school and without the prior permission of the government, school shall not be transferred.

3) The educational institution shall comply with all government orders and rules in force and issued from time to time relating to educational institutions.
