- The above certificate is issued under the following conditions:
1. To sub-salt numbers of rule 7 of Patwari's Educational Bill.
 2. The school incorporated fixed stamp in accordance with rule 9 of Rule

will then be specified and all written facilities
shall be provided.

(d) As per government rules no. 101 M.L.S. 7/38
dated 10.3.38 the law requires the parent of
anyday or permanent school at Rajgirwara to make
regular contributions.

The petitioner from the place where the
institution resides has given him the following primary
school as his own and it is necessary for him contrib-
utes to cater to the educational needs of the local
population to the judgement of the Honorable Supreme
Court the constitutional right of free education to
children under the age of 14 years has been
enacted and protection made mandatory.

State government responsibility can be placed
through private educational institution and other
organisations and with the issue of free primary
and children grant freedom of choice and said
school has been registered with permanent
address book because of the non existence of
the said educational institution.

(e) While no encouragement the educational
institutions are permitted to open with dis-
tinguish the report of the department.

(f) Screening shall be done only in the medium
and at the same location for which the school
has been sanctioned and shall be affixed to
each direction for any reason.

(g) The school shall be run at the same place
and under the same name by Board of trustees
for which permission has been granted by regular
of school and without the prior permission
of the government, a local election boardman.

(h) The educational institution shall comply
with all government orders and rules in force
and issued from time to time relating to education
and health.
